# GREYRecipes

## Summer Skillet Gnocchi with Grilled Corn and Burrata



### INGREDIENTS

4 ears corn, shucked  
 4 tablespoons unsalted butter, divided  
 3 cups cherry tomatoes  
 1 tablespoon extra-virgin olive oil  
 Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper  
 1 pound store-bought gnocchi  
 1 red onion, sliced  
 3 garlic cloves, minced  
 4 ounces arugula  
 Crushed red-pepper flakes, grated  
 Parmesan cheese, burrata cheese and  
 fresh basil leaves, for serving

### DIRECTIONS

1. Set a grill pan over high heat. Brush each ear of corn with ½ tablespoon melted butter. Grill the corn until charred and tender, 5 to 7 minutes. Cut the kernels off the cobs and set aside.  
 2. Place a cast-iron skillet on the

burner. In a medium bowl, toss the tomatoes with the olive oil and then season with salt and pepper. Sauté the tomatoes until charred and blistered, about 4 minutes. Remove from heat and set aside.  
 3. Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil. Add the gnocchi and cook until they float to the surface, 4 to 5 minutes; drain.  
 4. In the skillet, melt the remaining 2 tablespoons butter over medium heat. Add the onion and sauté until translucent, about 4 minutes. Add the garlic, gnocchi, corn and tomatoes, and sauté until the garlic is fragrant, about 2 minutes. Add the arugula and cook until wilted, about 3 minutes.  
 5. Remove the skillet from the heat and top with red pepper flakes, Parmesan, burrata and basil. Serve immediately.
